Origin:

1665–75; < L: back-support, apparatus. for *fulcrum*, equiv. to *fulc(īre)* to hold up, support + *-trum* n. suffix of instrument

Definition:

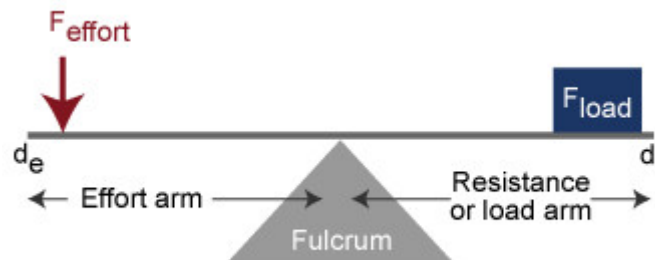
1. (Physics): the point on which an object balances or turns

Synonyms: *frame, foundation, support, scaffold, framework*

2. the person or thing that is depended upon

Synonyms: *feature, priority, element, basis*
